

BUXTON UNITED REFORMED CHURCH - COVID 19 DECLARATION
TO BE SIGNED BY GROUP ORGANISERS FROM NOVEMBER 2020

1. I understand that the Church has made the building “Covid Secure” as far as is possible for a multi-use building.
2. I understand that, inevitably, there is some infection risk for me and for the members of my group in using it.
3. I agree to follow the Church’s Covid requirements on the signs in the building
4. I have read and agree the Health & Safety policies, including the Covid 19 policy, on the church’s website www.buxtonurc.org.uk
5. I understand that the building may close again on very short notice if church leaders decide that the infection risk has become too great (or if I do not comply with this declaration) and that I will then be refunded any advance payments made by me.
6. I will not invite more than ten people to be in the building at any time. (I will ask that those collecting children will not enter the building and will wait outside). I understand that this is the building’s own limit and that it can be overridden by a lower number of people allowed by the government.
7. I understand that the building will be cleaned by the church cleaners twice a day and they will carry out a thorough sanitising if a known or suspected case of Covid has been present.
8. It is my responsibility to ensure that (a) all Government recommended social distancing, agreed purposes and handwashing is complied with and (b) All surfaces used by my groups will be sanitised by me after my groups have finished. I will use the sanitising materials supplied by the church (these can be found in the kitchen on the metal trolley)
9. If I become aware of a known or suspected case of Covid within my group I will immediately report this to a church officer.
10. I will keep a record of attendance by all members of my group and I will provide, immediately on request, details to church officers if they are required to provide Test and Trace information to the NHS under regulation 2(g) of the Government’s “Guidance for the safe use of multi-purpose community facilities.” Alternatively, in the case of children or vulnerable adults, I will provide that information directly to the NHS on demand.
11. I will indemnify the church if it suffers any loss because I have not done any of the above.
